APPROVE MINUTES

 a) MSP: Councilor Brandt/Demaris to accept the March 28, 2023, Council Meeting minutes as presented. All Councilors approved.

REPORTS

- a) Fire Chief Kurt Clarke
 - i) The Fire Chief expressed thanks to all volunteer fire fighters, City Council and John Young.
 - ii) Ten SVFD went to wildfire recertification class; training is continuing.
 - iii) There is required testing of re-built pumps coming up soon, testing costs \$300. Fire hose testing is needed as well.

NEW BUSINESS

- a) Gaslin Accounting Report Appropriations review: plenty of money in the general fund for the rest of the year. The Flea Market and roads are okay; however, water may need some adjustments by end of year and sewer is over extended. Bills: Baker Sanitary is a large expense this year (interceptor tank pumping), other significant expenses include OTEC, Gaslin Accounting, Paige Sully legal advice and Stage Stop. MSP: Councilor Demaris/Brandt motioned to approve paying the bills as presented. All Councilors approved.
- b) Resolution 418-23 Redwood Water Tank the resolution was read aloud. Councilor Smith stated that the person who removes the tank should be qualified and provide a Certificate of Insurance. This should be added to the resolution. A Notice of Sealed Bid Sale will be advertised. MSP: Councilor Demaris/Smith motioned to approve resolution 418-23 with additions for qualified/insured contractor for tank removal. All Councilors approved.
- c) Resolution 417-23 Road Graders the resolution was read aloud. An advertisement will include timeframe for bids, removal, minimum bid, highest bidder bears the cost of removal, and the graders will be sold as a package deal. MSP Councilor Smith/Briscoe motioned to approve resolution 417-23 as written and proceed with sealed bid sale. All Councilors approved.

OLD BUSINESS - none

COUNCIL COMMENT

- a) Councilor Smith Oregon Excavating: The Certificate of Insurance (COI) was received from the underground excavation contractor; however, the contract is not completed. There is plenty of time prior to June 1, 2023, to complete it.
- b) Councilor Briscoe per Tim Jacobson, City of Joseph (Levi Tickner) has a truck with a 1000 gallon stainless steel tank that could be donated to the City of Sumpter. It could be used for a water tank or for sewer pumping. Since the SVFD water tender can't be used as a water truck, this truck could fill a need.

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The Councilor expressed that it could be a "money pit" and should be evaluated for its overall state of repair.

c) Mayor Wise – the Baker County Planning Department has approved the addition of a T-Mobile antenna(s) to the tower in Sumpter. The mayor is informing the council and will find out what T-Mobile will pay Sumpter for the service.
